The Benedictine Order, founded in the 6th century, is one of the oldest monastic traditions in Christianity, emphasising prayer, work, and community life guided by the Rule of St. Benedict. Little Malvern Priory has deep roots in this tradition. Established in the 12th century, it served as a spiritual centre for monks who followed a life of devotion and discipline. Though the monastery was dissolved during the Reformation, the Priory Church remains a lasting symbol of the Benedictine legacy in the Malvern Hills.
